In accordance with the new regulation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of Thailand, the services of visa issuance and document legalization at the Royal Thai Honorary Consulate-General / Honorary Consulate over the world will end on 27 May, 2021. The Royal Thai Honorary Consulate-General Nagoya therefore will terminate the services of visa issuance and document legalization on the above -mentioned date.

However, the above-said services are still available at the Royal Thai Embassy in Tokyo and the Royal Thai Consulates-General, both in Osaka and Fukuoka.

The Royal Thai Honorary Consulate-General Nagoya will continue to carry out other major responsibilities and activities as the Honorary Consulate-General, such as protection and support for Thai nationals, and promotion of investment and tourism in the Kingdom of Thailand, to contribute to the development of the Kingdom and good relations between the Kingdom and Japan.
